1. EVENT SCHEDULE

Registration and check measurement:	9:30 AM to 10.00 AM
Briefing	10:15AM
First Race	10:30AM
A lunch break may be scheduled at the discretion of the PRO.	
Last Race Start	before 4:00PM

2. VENUE

The Patawalonga Lake, Anderson Ave, Glenelg North, S.A

3. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The event is organised under the overall authority of the Australian Radio Yachting Association (Incorporated) (ARYA) and conducted by the Adelaide Radio Control Yacht Racing Club Inc. and it's duly appointed Race Committee.

4. RULES

The regatta will be governed by The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2009-2012 (RRS) as changed by Appendix E of the RRS - Radio Controlled Boat Racing Rules, this Notice of Race (NoR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), International Class Administration Rules, the Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS) and the respective International Class Rules. The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in the event of conflict with this Notice of Race.

5. ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to financial members of ARYA (Inc) affiliated clubs and to members of a recognized Division Member of the International Sailing Federation-Radio Sailing Division. All yachts must have a current registration certificate for the class entered.

6. REGISTRATION

Boats, together with their current registration certificate, must be presented for registration and check-measurement by 9:30 and 10.00 on the day of competition. No boat will be eligible to race until it has completed this process.

7. EVENT CATEGORY AND ADVERTISING

This event is classified under the ISAF Advertising Code Regulation 20.3.1 (b) as Category C.
The Organisers reserve the right to advertising according to Regulation 20.3

8. SCORING AND RACING SYSTEM

The current Heat Management System (HMS) as approved by the ISAF-RSD will be used. Where there are less than 21 competitors, the event will be sailed in one fleet.

9. MEASUREMENT

The Race Committee may direct that all boats entered in the event be check-measured or alternatively randomly select a number of boats for check measurement. Random spot checks may be conducted throughout the duration of the event.

10. FREQUENCIES

For frequency bands other than 2.4 Ghz, each competitor is required to nominate a minimum of three (3) frequencies with their entry. The listing of additional frequencies if available would be helpful. Permitted frequency bands are 27, 29, 36, 40MHz and 2.4 GHz.

11. PROTESTS

A Committee will be appointed to hear any protests arising from the event and may comprise competitors not involved in the incident. RRS 61.2 and 62.2 may be replaced by a verbal notification and hearing if all parties affected by the incident agree.

12. ENTRIES

Entries shall be made on the official entry form.

OR presented to the race committee on the day of the event.

It would be appreciated if entrants emailed John Johnson (johnjoenny@bigpond.com) to advise their intentions to sail.

The entry fee for this event is **\$10.00** (Lunch NOT provided on this occasion).

Payment of the entry fee will be accepted on the day at the time of registration and measurement. Correct money would be appreciated as change may not be available.

Entries will not be accepted from members who are un-financial at the close of entries.

Cheques to be made payable to Adelaide Radio Control Yacht Racing Club Inc. and marked "Not Negotiable". *Please do not send cash.*

13. PRIZES AND TROPHIES

Trophies will be presented for the first 3 places.
