# NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. Event Schedule

The Bridge-to-Bridge Weekend will be held on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2007.

**2. Venue**

**3. Organising Authority**

**The event is organized under the overall authority of the Australian Radio Yachting Association (Incorporated) (ARYA), the ACT Radio Yachting Association (Incorporated) and conducted by the Canberra Model Yacht Club and its duly appointed Race Committee.**

**4. Rules**

**The event will be governed by The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2005-2008 (RRS), appendix E of the RRS - Radio Controlled Boat Racing Rules, this notice of race (NOR), the sailing instructions (SI), International Class Administration Rules, the equipment rules of sailing (ERS) and the respective international class rules.**

**5. Sportsmanship**

**All skippers entering the event are reminded that we are all out there for enjoyment and keeping the fun in sport, giving everyone a fair go, respecting fellow competitors and officials, and doing our best regardless of winning or losing. Any person as is covered in the RRS who brings the sport into disrepute will be disciplined or will be disqualified from the event.**

**6. Eligibility**

The competition is open to financial members of the ARYA (Inc), affiliated clubs and to members of a recognized Division Member of the International Sailing Federation – Radio Sailing Division. All yachts must have a current registration certificate for the class entered.

#### **7. Registration**

Boats, together with their registration certificate, must be presented for registration and check-measurement between 8.30 – 9.30 on the first day of competition. **No boat will be eligible to race until it has completed this process.**

#### **8. Event Category and Advertising**

The event is classified under the ISAF Advertising Code Regulation 20.3.1 (b) as Category C.  
The organizers have the right to advertising according to Regulation 20.3

#### **9. Scoring and Racing System**

The event is open to all radio controlled yachts.  
The scoring system used for this event is the Lake Burley Griffin yardstick, which gives each class of boat a rating, which has been designed to give all classes of boat a chance of winning the event.

#### **10. Measurement**

The Race Committee may direct that all boats entered in the event be check – measured or alternatively randomly select a number of boats for check measurement.  
Random sport checks may be conducted throughout the duration of the event.

#### **11. Frequencies**

Each competitor is required to nominate a minimum of three (3) frequencies with their entry. The listing of additional frequencies would be helpful. Permitted frequency bands are 27, 29, 36 and 40 MHz.

## 12. Protests

A committee will be appointed to hear any protests arising from the event and may comprise competitors not involved in the incident.
