1. Event Schedule

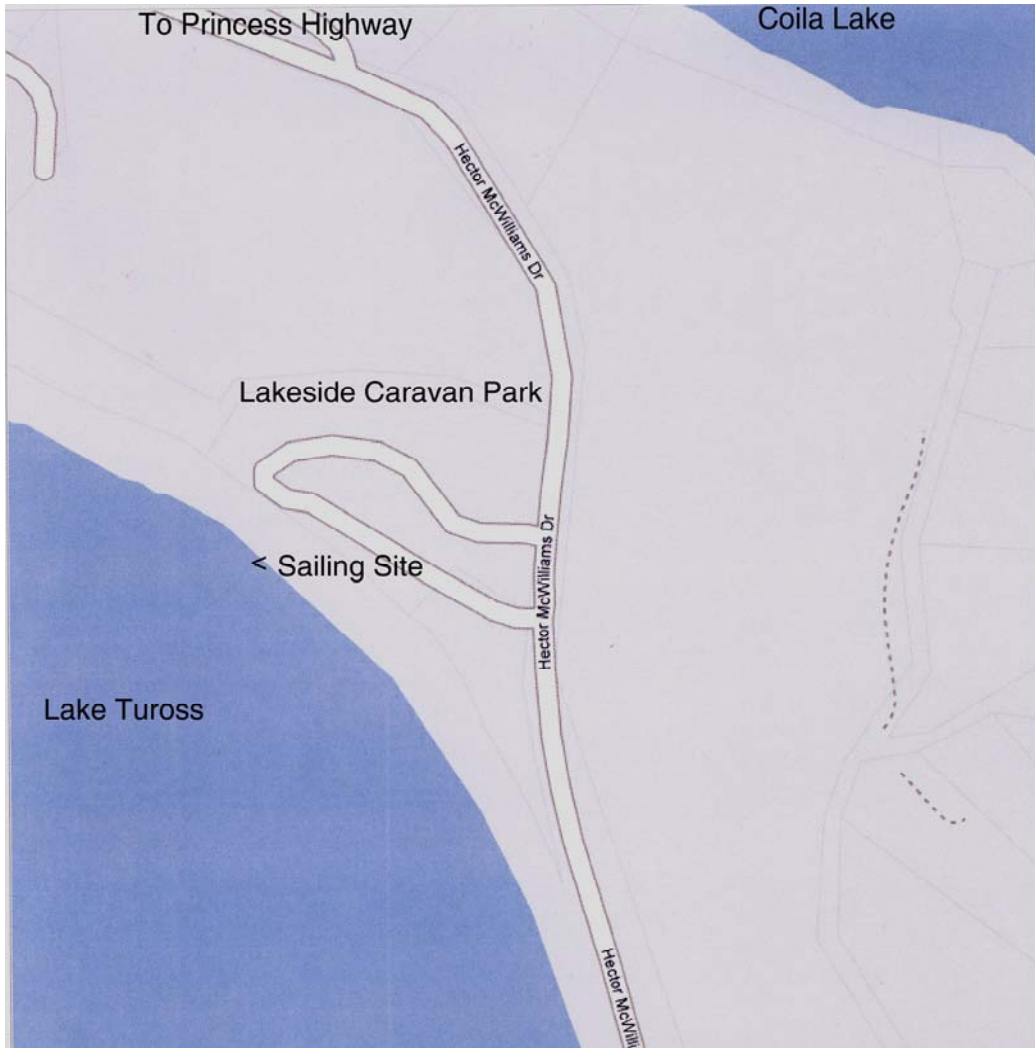

3. Organising Authority

The Championships are organised under the overall authority of the Australian Radio Yachting Association (Incorporated) (ARYA), the ACT Radio Yachting Association (Incorporated), conducted by the National Capital Radio Yacht Club (Inc.) and its duly appointed race committee,

4. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2005 - 2008 (RRS) as changed by Appendix E of the RRS – Radio Controlled Boat Racing Rules, this Notice of Race (NOR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), the International Class Administration Rules, the Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS) and the respective International Class Rules. The Sailing

Instructions shall prevail in the event of conflict with this Notice of Race. The AYF prescription to RRS 46 DOES NOT APPLY.

5. Sportsmanship

All skippers entering the championship are reminded that we are all out there for enjoyment and keeping fun in sport, giving everyone a fair go, respecting fellow competitors and officials, and doing our best regardless of winning or losing. Any person as is covered in the RRS who brings the sport into disrepute will be disciplined or will be disqualified from the championship.

6. Eligibility

The competition is open to financial members of the ARYA (Inc.), affiliated clubs and members of a recognised Division Member of the International Sailing Federation – Radio Sailing Division. All yachts must have a current registration certificate for the class entered.

7. Registration

Boats of both classes, together with their current registration certificate, must be presented for registration and measurement check between 8.30 – 9.15 on the first day of competition for that class. **No boat will be eligible to race until it has completed this process.**

8. Event Category and Advertising

The championships are classified under the ISAF Advertising Code Regulation 20.3.1 (b) as Category C. The organisers reserve the right to advertising according to regulation 20.3.

9. Scoring and Racing System

The Current Heat Management System (HMS) as approved by the ISAF – RSD will be used. Where there are less than 16 competitors the event will be sailed in one fleet.

10. Measurement

The Race Committee may direct that all boats entered in the Championship be check measured or alternatively randomly select a number of boats for check measurement.

Random spot checks may be conducted throughout the duration of the championships.

11. Frequencies

Each competitor is required to nominate a minimum of three (3) frequencies with their entry. The listing of additional frequencies if available would be helpful.

PERMITTED FREQUENCY BANDS ARE, 27, 29, 36 AND 40MHz.

12. Protests

A committee will be appointed to hear any protests arising from the event and may comprise competitors not involved in the incident.

13. Entries

Entries must be made on the official entry form (a separate form for each class entered) and forwarded to:-

Entries will not be accepted from members who are unfinancial at the close of entries. The entry fee of \$20.00 per class must accompany the entry form. Cheques made payable to “National Capital Radio Yacht Club (Inc.)” and marked “Not Negotiable”. Please do not send cash.

Tea and coffee will be available and lunch will be provided on both days.

Entries Close on 4th July 2008.

Late entries may be accepted up until registration on the first day on payment of an additional \$10.00 late fee.

14. Prizes and trophies

A perpetual trophy for each class, which shall remain the property of the National Capital Radio Yacht Club (Inc.), will be awarded.

Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be presented.

15. Liability

All those entering or taking part in these championships do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Australian Radio Yachting Association (Incorporated), The National Capital Radio Yacht Club (Inc.) and any other parties involved in this event disclaim:-

Any and every responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods, both ashore and on the water as a consequence of entering or participating in the Championships covered by this Notice of Race.

At all times the responsibility for safety of their boat and themselves plus the decision to participate or continue must rest with the competitors.
