



WYNNUM MANLY RADIO MODEL YACHT CLUB Inc. CLUB INFORMATION SHEET

Welcome to the Wynnum Manly Radio Model Yacht Club. I hope that you will enjoy sailing with us and that you will experience pleasure from joining in the club's activities.

To help you assimilate quickly into the club I thought it might help if I gave you some details of our sailing programme and the club organization:

- We sail on the **first** and **third** Sunday of each month.
- On the **first Sunday** we sail at **Carbrook Golf Club**. The program for this day is two six-monthly series of Scratch Races (November to April and then May to October).
- On the **third Sunday** in each month we sail at **Manly Harbour** or in the **Wynnum Wading Pool** if there is sufficient water and no swimmers! Again, we have the same two six-monthly series of Handicap Races as for the Scratch Racing series.
- Racing starts at 10.00 a.m. and finishes around 2.00 p.m.
- For both the Scratch and Handicap series of races each skipper drops the worst two positions for the day. Also the worst round in each series for each skipper is dropped. This is to allow for members who are unable to race in all six rounds being unfairly penalized.
- Families and spectators are encouraged to come along and give support to members. There are local shops available to purchase food and drinks.
- On Mondays, there is social sailing at the Wynnum Wading Pool or in Manly Harbour as per the locations for the first Sunday of each month. We start at 9.30 a.m. and finish around 12.30 p.m.
- There is also a small group that sails in the Wynnum Wading Pool on Wednesdays and Fridays.
- On Sundays and Mondays, the sailing fees are \$2 per boat per day.
- Inter-club, State and National Championships are publicised well in advance in the club's newsletter (News of the Wind). This is normally published every three months. It is distributed by e-mail or posted to those members who do not have this facility. If you have access to e-mail, please let the Secretary have the details and any changes that may occur during your membership.
- A Management Committee consisting of the Commodore, Vice-Commodore and Treasurer (or Secretary /Treasurer if appointed) manages the day-to-day activities and administration of the club.
- The Annual General meeting is normally held in May.
- Club dues are payable on 1st April and only financial members can vote at the AGM.
- If you have any queries or wish to make any suggestions to improve the running of the club, please contact a Committee member.
