

2007 ACT International 10 Rater Championship

The ACT International 10 Rater Championship was held on Saturday 6th October with four boats entered, but due to a fatal accident in the rigging area only three made it to the starting line.

Racing commenced at 10.00 a.m. with the wind strength around 15 Kph. Most boats opted for "C" rig with the wind gusting. After the first race all boats were on "C" rig as the wind slowly grew in strength, and by the time the last race was contested the wind had increased to around 30 Kph with gusts exceeding 35 Kph.

The final four races were reduced to two competitors due to one boat smashing the main sheet post which was not repairable at the venue.

The series was sailed in what one could only call very trying conditions.
