Hi All - A truly tough test for competitors and the officials this weekend, with strong winds and rain on Saturday and even stronger winds on the Sunday. 10 competitors greeted the starter, with Andrew Reid and Pat Parisienne from Victoria making the journey, with Andrew bringing a Prime Number design by Graham Bantock and Pat bringing a Scourge design by Linc McDowall - both boats beautifully prepared - Saturdays sailing started on B Rigs and progressed to C Rigs by Lunch when a front passed over with plenty of rain and squalls, the afternoon provided some excellent strong weather sailing with Denis McLoughlin, Michael Hickman, Andrew Reid, and Cassie Midgley at the head of the leaderboard at the end of Day 1 - Sunday brought even stronger winds with most competitors starting on C2 Rigs (4th Smallest Rig) and unfortunately Peter Darceys and Pats boats succumbed to the conditions and were out of the running for the rest of the day, a bit later Stuart Dawes, Berloiz design suffered the same fate and he sat the rest of the day out. Mat Gray in his Blink design had some excellent racing with Michael Hickman all morning and Michael jumped to the lead by lunch. Mats winch expired after lunch and he was out for the count, after some good results. As the wind picked even more Denis McLoughlin and Andrew Reid moved to their C3 rigs whilst Michael Hickman, Lisa Blackwood and Cassie Midgley struggled on with their C2 rigs, and they showed great skill in getting their boats around the track - Ken Dobbie had his rig virtually torn out of his Skalpel by a mini cyclone, but he rerigged and had the boat going better than ever to finish with a 4th a 3rd and 2 first places - After 27 races, Michael Hickman in his Ajax 2 design from Dario of Carbonic Boats took out his first Marblehead State Championship from Denis McLoughlin and Andrew Reid - A huge thank you to the PRO Alan Furmage and his capable race officials Les Hanson, John Webberley, and Ron Hickman - who stood their ground in the face of some nasty conditions and carried out their duties with good humour.
